Expressions of Interest are sought for the Editorship of <u>Human Figurations</u> [https://quod.lib.umich.edu/h/humfig/] to run for a period of three years from 1 December 2021.

Human Figurations is an interdisciplinary open-access, peer-reviewed journal supported and sponsored by the Norbert Elias Foundation [http://www.norberteliasfoundation.nl/]. Since its establishment in 2012 it has provided a unique international forum for interdisciplinary research on the long-term development of human societies. A key aim of the journal is to act as a counterpoint to ahistorical conceptualisations and approaches to knowledge on the social world that predominate within the social sciences. The journal engages scholars across sociology, history, politics, international relations, anthropology, criminology and geography, and especially those working in the interstices between traditional disciplines.

Applications are invited from Co-Editors (or editorial teams) whose expertise demonstrates breadth in relation to methodologies, geographies and disciplines. The editorial team will need to demonstrate a vision for how the journal should develop in the years ahead. Central to this should be broadening the scope and content of the journal, beyond its Eliasian roots, to engage with wider international debates and scholars in advancing interdisciplinary research and theorizing on the human condition that is historically informed.

This is an exciting opportunity to help shape and develop the journal over the coming three years. The Editors would work closely with the *Human Figurations* Board and the Norbert Elias Foundation Board in implementing their vision.
